

Operations Coordination

Responsibilities

I. Preparation

- Know the capabilities of your local emergency response organizations
- Study incidents reported in the media to learn what can happen and how other agencies handle different situations

II. Response

- Is responsible for coordinating the County wide emergency response
- Do not micro manage the Incident Commander(s)**
- Help the Incident Commander(s) with span-of control problems
- Assist the Emergency Services Coordinator in developing protective action measures for the general public
- Develop operational plans for emergency actions to be taken outside of the incident scene
- Consult with the IC and/or the Emergency Services Coordinator about the overall incident action plan
- Keep the EOC staff informed of the situation and resource status
- Work with the Resource/Logistics Manager, ESF 4 Firefighting, ESF 9 Search and Rescue, ESF 10 Oil and Hazardous Materials Response, or ESF 13 Public Safety and Security as required
- Assign priorities for resources

III. Recovery

- Same as response only with recovery objectives
