

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Bannock County Commissioners will hold a public hearing on Thursday, September 22, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commissioners Chambers, Bannock County Courthouse, Room 212, to reopen the Fiscal Year 2022 budget to reflect the receipt of unanticipated monies and the allocation of such as follows:

The Road and Bridge fund has received unanticipated State revenues and also reimbursements for surveyor fees. It is requested to use these funds to cover increased fuel costs and hot mix overlay for the road and bridge department; and also cover survey fees that may exceed the anticipated budget. Monies will be distributed as follows:

The Bannock County Events fund will be established with unanticipated revenues that will be received from ARPA funds. Monies will be allocated as follows:




