WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code 2-216(2), the Administrative District Judge may specify a jury term of service shorter than six (6) months in any county within the judicial district; and

WHEREAS, persons in Bannock County are currently required to be available for jury service for a term of an entire calendar month; and

WHEREAS, the court has received recommendations from the Bannock County Jury Commissioner regarding the need to make the administration of the jury system in Bannock County more efficient.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that effective April 1, 2023, jury service in Bannock County shall be set as follows:

Every calendar month will be divided equally based upon the number of judicial days in a given month. Bannock County jury service will be for the first half or the second half of those equally divided days for the month in which the person is summoned. If the number of judicial days in a calendar month cannot be equally divided, the Jury Commissioner shall alternate between the first half and second half of unequal months to assign the additional day of jury service.

Persons who were granted a postponement of their service prior to the effective date of this Order shall be required to serve under the new jury service term set under this Order.

Additionally, Administrative Order 2020-32 is hereby rescinded and replaced.
