Meeting Notes

- 1 9:00 AM Moser called the meeting to order.
- 2 9:00 AM Community Resources and Advocacy Director Shantal Lauu presented cremation applications for case numbers 20250007 and 20250008. Hough moved to approve case numbers 20250007 and 20250008. The motion passed.
- 3 9:02 AM Chief Deputy Treasurer Misty Katsilometes also appeared. Valentine requested approval of tax specials on the 2024 taxes for the cities and the Department of Lands. Hough moved to approve the 2024 tax roll specials. The motion passed.
- 4 9:04 AM Sheriff Tony Manu and Chief Deputy Sheriff Alex Hamilton also appeared. Crystal reviewed the asphalt contract. Hough moved to approve the contract with Superior Asphalt. The motion passed.
9:06 AM Crystal reviewed the potential award for the tactical training center bid that came in over budget and options for funding. It is recommended to award a contract to Pro Builders in an amount not to exceed \$584,936 and take the opportunity to value engineer with the goal to come in closer to the original budget. Klauser gave options of funding the overage.
9:10 AM Juvenile Probation Director Matt Olsen, Business and Events Director Scott Crowther, and Facilities Director Dan Kendall appeared. Crystal reviewed the YDC/Event Center building project and recommended awarding to Headwaters Construction in an amount not to exceed \$2,346,483. This project came in over budget.
9:12 AM Klauser gave an ARPA project list update below.
9:29 AM Following the ARPA update, the projects can move forward. Hough moved to award the tactical building to Pro Builders in an amount not to exceed \$584,936 and to award the YDC/Event Center building to Headwaters Construction in an amount not to exceed \$2,346,483. The motion passed.
- 5 9:12 AM Klauser reviewed updates to ARPA projects. An updated list was submitted with proposed allocation changes that follow reporting requirements. She suggested using PILT funds and reallocations in ARPA to complete the projects above.
- 6 9:32 AM Hough moved to enter into executive session under Idaho Code §74-206(1)(f) to communicate with legal counsel. The motion passed by roll call vote.
9:43 AM Hough moved to exit executive session. The motion passed. Moser relayed there will be further discussions and a field trip with Dixon and Dye to view areas to relocate drug testing.
- 7 9:43 AM Moser reviewed the resolutions and that 2024-68 will have a correction to the Downey general fund that is missing a zero. Hough moved to approve the levy resolution adjustment as discussed and Resolutions 2024-68, 69, 70, 71, and 72.
- 8 9:45 AM Hough moved to approve the Quit claim deeds and the contract with Mountain Shadow Landscaping. The motion passed.
- 9 9:46 AM Moser reviewed the consent agenda included a salary form and minutes. The motion passed.
- 10 11:00 AM Assistant Public Works Director Tristan Bourquin and Public Works Director Kiel Burmester appeared. Moser reviewed the public hearing notice and process. Hough moved to enter the public hearing. The motion passed.
11:01 AM Staff expressed no concerns for application.
11:02 AM Todd Hawkins, Neptune Street, explained he is the applicant. The easement has not been used since the subdivision was created, over 51 years. His attorney, Kent Higgins, is also present. Hawkins

reviewed contents of the staff report that recommended approval to vacate the easement and relayed that every property has several access points.

11:03 AM Wes Johnson, Saturn Street, lives near the property. He belongs to an irrigation group and one of the irrigation ditches goes through the easement. He is concerned how it would affect the ditch if a road is ever built.

11:05 AM Attorney Kent Higgins relayed the easement has never been used and he is not aware of any objection to vacating it.

11:06 AM Jim Cunningham, Laramie Lane, explained he has owned property nearby for 40 years. He inquired of the easement when he bought the property for access so a road would not have to go across his end of the acreage. The lot is ready to build on. It would landlock that acreage.

11:08 AM Hough moved to close the public hearing. The motion passed. Bourquin relayed no concerns and explained Cunningham’s parcel currently has access at end of Laramie Lane at the cul-de-sac. If a subdivision application is submitted, a requirement would be to provide access from Laramie Lane to any new parcels. As it currently sits, there is access. Questions were addressed on subdividing and access.

11:10 AM Hough moved to approve the vacation request. The motion passed.
