

**WHEREAS**, on February 21, 2024, The Honorable Judge Robert C. Naftz issued a DECISION ON APPEAL FROM MAGISTRATE DIVISION on Case No. CV03-23-1072, wherein it was found that the Sixth Judicial District Local Rule 6.1, pertaining to Attorney Fees Guidelines on Default Judgements, is in direct contradiction of Idaho Rule of Civil Procedure 54(e)(3);

**AND WHEREAS**, it has been determined that Local Rule 6.1 violates the district court's rule-making authority as stipulated in Idaho Rules of Civil Procedure 1(c), rendering it invalid;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, effective immediately, Sixth Judicial Court Local Rule 6.1 Attorney Fees Guidelines on Default Judgements is **RESCINDED**.
