

## Applicant's Next of Kin

A driver's license or ID card applicant's next of kin information is made available to law enforcement and coroner's offices for the purpose of contacting next of kin in the event of an emergency involving the applicant.

- Traditional next of kin is highly encouraged. (See [Hierarchy of Relations](#))
- An applicant may name up to two (2) next of kin who are eighteen (18) years of age or older by providing their name and phone number.
- An applicant may list anyone who is 18 years or older.
- An applicant may opt out from providing next of kin information.

You can update your next of kin by going online (*scan the QR code*) or to a DMV office.

*A person named next of kin on an applicant's record may have their name removed by completing and submitting an ITD Form 4444 for each applicant naming them as a next of kin.*
