


# Q1 Where is your primary residence located?



## Q2 Do you own a secondary residence or property in Bannock County?





## Q5 How important is it to you to preserve ground water quality?



## Q6 How important is it to you to preserve natural resources? I.e. mining, timbering, etc.?



## Q7 How important to you is it to preserve "agricultural" uses?



## Q8 How important to you is it to preserve wild life habitat area?



## Q9 How important to you is it to preserve wild life migration areas?



### Q10 How important is it for you to have "proximity" to services? I.e. shopping, gas station, groceries, etc.?




