

Q1 What is your solution to promote responsible growth in Bannock County?

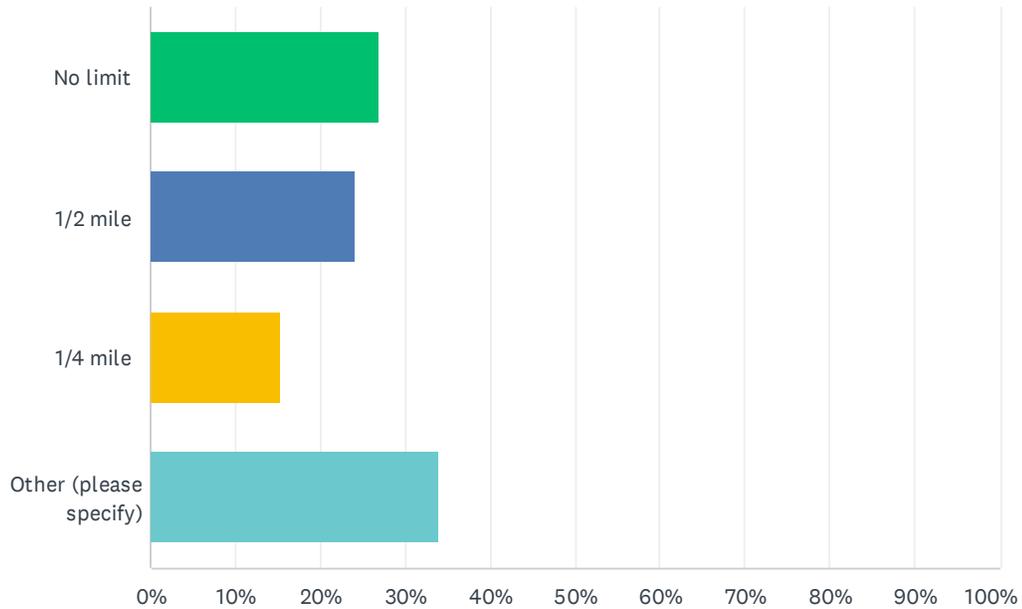

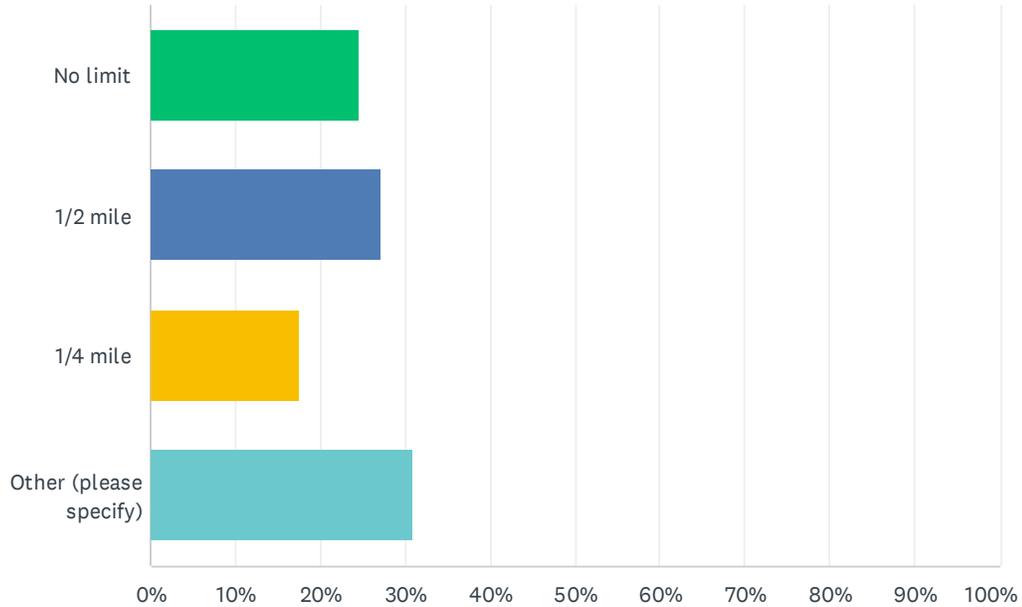

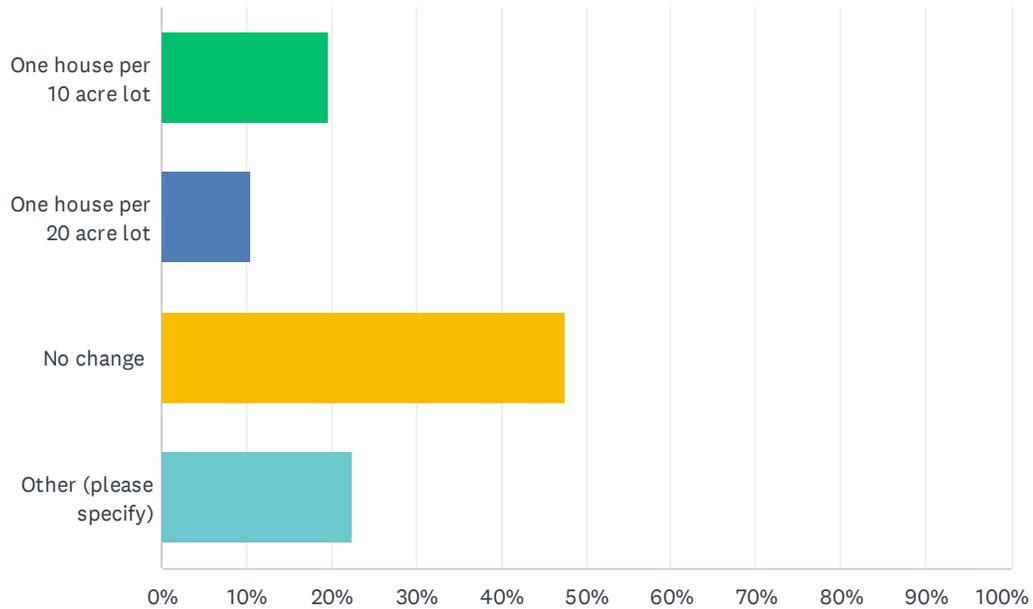

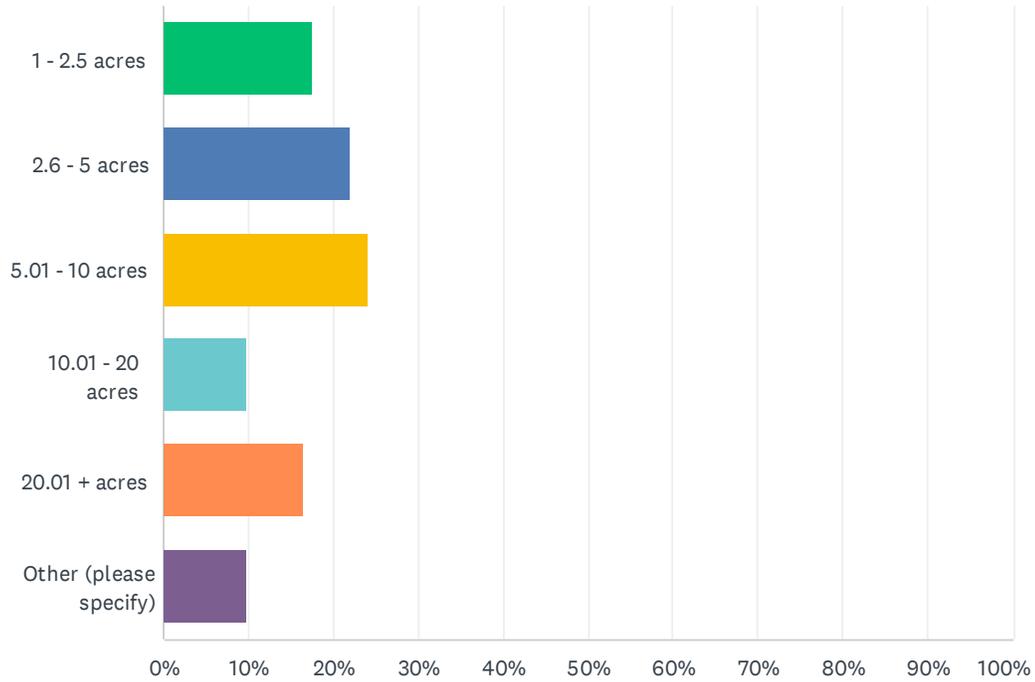

Q10 What is your preferred lot size if you lived outside city limits?

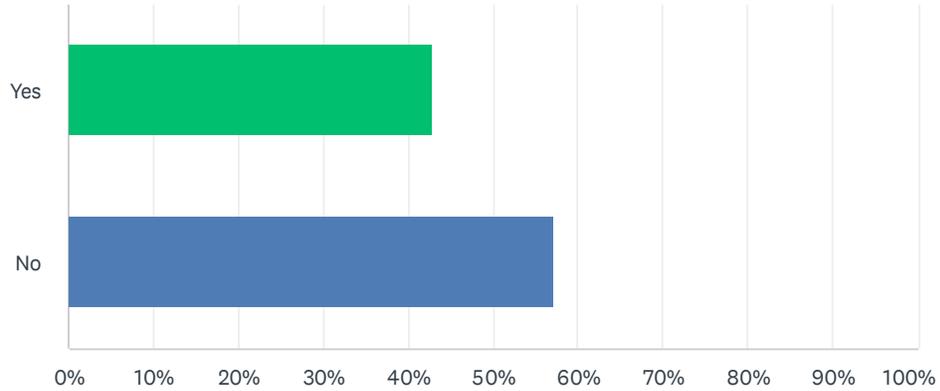

Q11 When connecting to city services (water, sewer, etc.), do you think there should be a minimum lot size requirement?

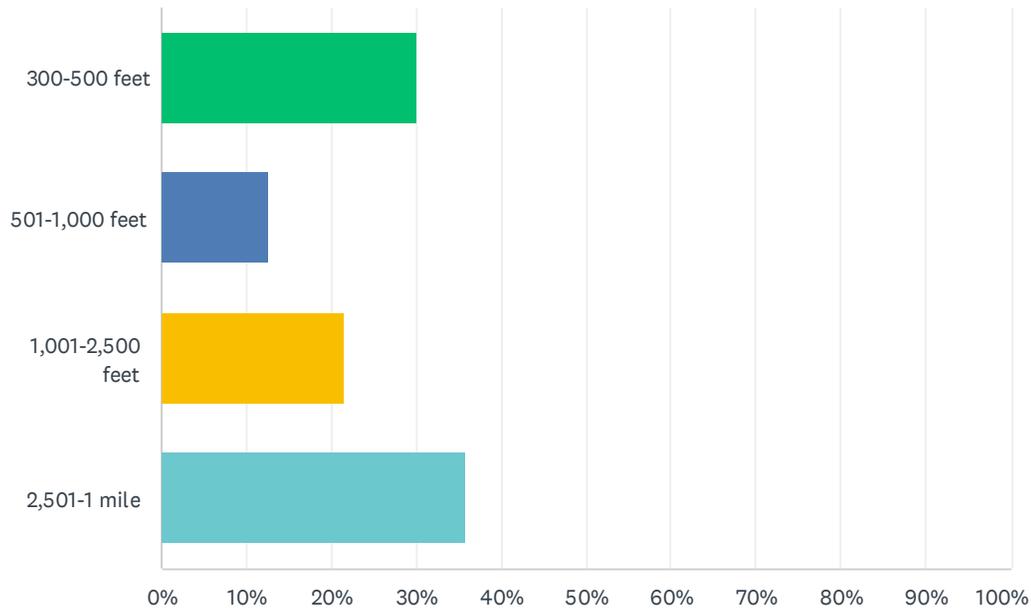
